FLOWER TOWER



The Airplot Flower towers are built using natural materials used in Britain for centuries. The stems are Oak with steel fixings and the hut on top is made of willow. Designed at human scale, to house one or two activists each, the towers are anchored to a small concrete base to ensure a minimal footprint.

The use of materials reflects the local dialect of nature's colouring and weathers in accordance with the surroundings. The proposal is not only for 17 towers to be built on the Airplot, but also for additional hedgerow planting with native species to provide year round shelter and food for wildlife.

The orchard will be continued across the Airplot, with apple, pears and plum trees. A wheat field with native wildflowers will be sown under the trees and flower towers, to visually link the Airplot to its surroundings and to provide shelter for birds and small mammals and a varied source of pollen for bees and butterflies.

The Airplot will become all that is worth fighting for and saving, Community, tradition, diversity and sustainability. The English countryside.
